Eligibility | Requirements

- US Citizen or permanent resident
- Rising Juniors or Seniors, exceptional rising Sophomores
 - Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Chemistry Majors or strong emphasis in related chemistry coursework
- Women, students with disabilities, and underrepresented minority students (defined by NSF as African American/Black, Hispanic/Latino, American Indian, Alaska Native, and Pacific Islander) particularly targeted.
